Bus Information

- ❖ GFMS and GFES will be combined on buses this year.
- ❖ Elementary students will ride in the front half with Middle in the back half.
- ❖ No more than one student per seat unless they live in the same home.
- ❖ Masks must be worn the whole time.
- ❖ Students are expected to sit where instructed.

Masks

It is county policy for every person in the building to follow the State guidelines for wearing a face cover. Students and adults are to wear a cloth face mask at all times. Masks can be removed when the individual is more than 6 feet apart, some PE activities, eating, and giving speeches in class.



Entering School Procedures

1. Students will need to social distance outside if they arrive before 7:15.
2. They need to stand on the black 'X's' and wait their turn to enter.
3. Students and adults must be wearing a face mask in order to enter the building.
4. Students will be directed to place their hand over a new thermal thermometers or a staff member will take their forehead temperature with an infrared thermometer, and will be asked a series of questions regarding their exposure to COVID-19.
5. Once students have been screened, they will report to their homeroom. We will not be holding students in communal areas in the mornings.

Travel Patterns within the School

1. Students will be staying in their homerooms and teachers will travel to each room when it is time to change classes. Including during OE's
2. Some OE classes will involve traveling to a new classroom but not all. Your student will be given more information the first day of school.
3. Students will not move independently throughout the building unless it is an emergency or otherwise given permission to do so.
4. We will have to remain on the right side of the hall and have three steps in between each student as we travel through the building.
5. We will enter the cafeteria through the doors at the bus parking lot and will exit through the doors located near the OE building.
6. Bathroom breaks have been scheduled throughout the day to ensure supervision and social distancing.
