Welcome to Mr. Atkins's science and social studies class! I am excited to be back at GFMS this year and outlook forward to working with your child. The following information will give you an overview of my expectations I have for your child.

Grading:

Classwork/Quizzes 60%

Remote Assignments 40%

******These percentages could change if we move to Plan C (remote)**

Wednesday Science/Social Studies Online Office Times: 11:00-11:30

I will send an email link to all students Wednesday morning. If this time does not work and needs extra help please have them email me.

Classwork: Your child will keep a notebook of activities which we will complete in class. I will do random notebook checks to ensure the students are staying organized and completing all work. Students will also complete Google Classroom assignments based on the material that is taught in class.

Quizzes: Quizzes will be given to check for understanding throughout the school year. Students will be allowed to use their notes and notebook.

Homework: Any daily classwork assignment which is not completed in class will then become homework to be completed on Wednesdays. With our hybrid model, students will complete Google Classroom homework assignments for both science **and** social studies. This work may be based on material taught in school or as an introduction to a future lesson.

Make-up Work: Students will need to check Google Classroom for assignments when they are out of school.

Missing Work: It is imperative that students complete all of their work in a timely manner. Classwork/Homework is due when the students return to school. However, if a student does not complete his/her work by the due date, a late grade may be given. If missing work becomes a problem, I will contact the parent and/or guardian.

Correction: Correcting any assignment is an effective form of remediation. Students may redo any assignment or quiz for a better grade. Students must communicate with the teacher regarding this policy.

Behavior: All students are expected to be on their best behavior at all times. Students will have to follow the new rules that have been implemented as we navigate through this hybrid school

year. Face masks are to be worn at all times while in the building unless instructed otherwise by their teacher or administrator. We also have to follow strict guidelines as we navigate through the building as a class as well as independently. We ask that you and your child be patient with us as we determine how to effectively implement these new policies. These policies are to protect all students and may evolve as the year continues.
