

2022-2023 MERIT SYSTEM

Purpose

- #1. To instill a sense of pride and worth to the band program at William Lenoir Middle School.
- #2. To recognize and reward band students who go above and beyond expectations through volunteer work, fundraising, and leadership throughout the year.
- #3. The recognition will come through a “Merit Night” for the selected students.

Procedures and Policies

- #1. 8th grade presidents and class representatives are responsible throughout the year for management of Merit Points.
- #2. Merit System should be maintained at least once per week.
- #3. Additional Merit points not described below are only awarded by band director.
- #4. Merit points are not awarded if job or office is not fulfilled.
- #5. For 2022-2023 – Merit Night Invitations will require 1,000 points by May 16, 2023.
- #6. Any student assigned any kind of suspension (ISS or OSS) from the office for any infraction, is automatically ineligible for Merit Night.
- #7. Any other blatant disregard for policies found in the student handbook or stated in the rules for band also disqualifies students from the Merit program.
