

GRADING OF EXCEPTIONAL STUDENTS

Appropriate instructional modifications for exceptional students, as stipulated in the students' Individual Education Plan, can include curriculum content, difficulty level, and/or grading.

Exceptional students can earn any grade on the A-E(F) scale or the O-S-U scale. The grade should reflect the student's performance on the work presented.

The Student Information Management System assigns a number to every course taken by each student. Exceptional courses are identified in the course number. Therefore, no further notation is necessary on the report card.

All students are eligible for honor rolls.
