INFORMATION AND REGULATIONS

Dear Senior and/or Guest,

We invite you to participate in Caldwell County's Project Graduation 2012. This is our 24th annual extravaganza. In order for you to attend, you and your parent/guardian must complete the accompanying SENIOR RELEASE/CONSENT form and return it to your school by **Friday**, **June 1**, **2012**. Even if you are unsure that you will attend this function, it is to your advantage to submit your form, keeping the option available to you. **Late applications will not be accepted.**

You may invite one guest. Tickets for guests are \$10.00 each, payable by June 1, 2012 at your school. If your guest is not a senior in Caldwell County, he/she must complete a GUEST RELEASE/CONSENT form and submit it along with your form. Your guest must arrive and be checked in with you. Your personal invitation(s) will be sent upon receipt of this/these fully completed and signed form(s). The invitation, along with photo identification, (driver's license) will be required for admittance for you and your guest on the evening of June 8, 2012.

PLEASE READ THE FOLLOWING RULES CAREFULLY!

- 1. All participants must come drug and alcohol free.
- 2. Graduates and guests (between ages 16-22) must arrive prior to 11:30 p.m.
- 3. Each person must have an invitation and photo I.D. for admittance.
- 4. Parents/quardians may be called in case of emergency or disorderly behavior.
- 5. Participants may leave, but may not return after leaving.
- 6. Tobacco in any form will not be allowed.
- 7. Mature behavior will be expected.
- 8. Each graduate may bring one guest who must have a ticket and must have signed a CONSENT/RELEASE form in advance. Guest tickets are \$10.00
- 9. Only graduates may win door prizes, and they must be present to win.
- 10. Acceptable school attire, including shirts and shoes, is required. No bathing suits.
- 11. Foreign exchange students must be seniors at a Caldwell County High School and must comply with the same rules as other seniors.
- 12. Favors and mementos will be provided.
- 13. No food or beverages will be permitted outside of designated areas.
- 14. Students are encouraged to leave bulky purses, bags, etc. at home to allow mobility and involvement in the activities. Students are responsible and liable for any personal items brought to the event.
- 15. The Senior's guest must enter the event with the Senior.
- 16. A Guest may leave the event prior to the Senior, however, when the Senior leaves the event, the Guest must leave also.
