

LAB RULES AND EXPECTATIONS

In Learning Strategies Lab.....

- you will learn to be more organized and turn in ALL assignments given to you by ALL of your teachers
- You will learn to communicate with your teachers on lessons and assignments given by your teachers, especially if you do not understand an assignment
- You will learn what an IEP is
- You will become aware of the modifications and accommodations that you have within your general education classroom
- You will work on your IEP goals
- You will work on your transition activities listed on your IEP
- You will work on any missing assignments that you have in your classes
- You will be expected to use your time wisely in lab
- You will NOT be allowed to sleep or goof off during lab
- You are expected to be on time to class

Electronics Rule

- If you have missing assignments in ANY class, you will not be allowed to keep your phone out during class. You may be asked to leave your phone in your bookbag or you may be asked to put your phone in the front of the classroom at the beginning of class and pick it up when you leave at the end of class

If you hurry through an assignment just to have it marked as complete, you will be asked to redo the assignment, especially if you get a bad grade on that assignment.
