From PBIS dollar days we have collected \$378.00 after all purchases are made it will leave \$56.00 to carry over for next nine weeks.

PBIS store- PTO will donate the small shirts for kids to buy with 25 tickets.

Last general assembly meeting will be March 15th at 6:00pm. Officer election that night. If someone is interested let Mrs. Wright know before the ballot is printed. Next year looking at a call out ballot to avoid need of keeping track who is a PTO member and who isn't.

Be thinking about making changes to the PTO bylaws for next year this will include voting practices and job description/replacement procedure, and lower joining fee.

Penguin patch is a company that helps children be able to buy something for parents or guardian for Christmas. They come set up and have a range of items and prices so each child can afford something. They are sending more information.

Coke fundraiser will be April 4th-18th with final day for money and orders to be turned in on the 19th. We almost have all of the packets made. Mrs. Wright will send an email out to teachers to let them know we will be coming around to hand out packets and explain the program to the kids on April 4th. And a call out can be made when info packets are given out. (get what needs to be said to Mrs. Wright that day to make the call out). Coke rep will print us some banners to have out front to help remind parents of what we are doing, when pick up is, and thanks for supporting the school.
